

IMPORTANT UPDATED NOTICE—TOWNHOME RESIDENTS
TOWNHOME DRIVEWAY PAVING PROJECT

SEPTEMBER 5, 2013—12:00 NOON

PLEASE SAVE THIS NOTICE FOR FUTURE REFERENCE

Please disregard all prior notices.

If you only have one layer of asphalt (the binder) applied, you may now drive your car into your garage. **You must not park on the driveway or in the guest parking area.**

All of those driveways that have had the second coat of asphalt applied on Wednesday, September 4th, must not be driven upon for any reason for at least three (3) full days. On Saturday evening, September 7th, at the earliest, you may then drive your cars into your garage. **There must not be any parking on the driveways or "Guest Parking" areas for at least an additional four weeks.**

For those driveways that have not yet had the second coat of asphalt applied, be advised that on Monday, September 9th, your cars must be on the street by no later than 7:00 a.m. so that the second coat of asphalt can be applied. Once the second coat of asphalt is applied, you must not drive on your driveway for at least three (3) full days thereafter. After the three (3) full days, you will only be allowed to drive into your garage. **As stated above, there must not be any parking in your driveway or in the "Guest Parking" areas for at least an additional four weeks.**

If you are not certain whether the second layer of asphalt was applied, you can tell by checking to see if the asphalt is flush with the concrete next to your garage and also flush with the sidewalks and the curb by the street.

No delivery trucks will be allowed for any reason on the driveway or guest parking areas for at least 4 weeks from the time of the application of the second coat of the asphalt.

We also suggest that you keep your dogs off the driveway so they don't get any of the asphalt stuck in their paws.

At all times, please do not drive close to the edges of the driveways.
