

# COROMANDEL UPDATE

## May 2020

### OUTDOOR & INDOOR POOLS

The Coromandel Umbrella Association will take its direction regarding the opening of the pools from The Village of Deerfield, Lake County Health Department and the Illinois Department of Public Health.

In a conversation with a Deerfield Parks & Recreation Representative we were told that there are no plans at this point to open the Deerfield Public Pools. The Parks Department is waiting for guidelines from the Illinois Department of Public Health concerning opening of pools.

With respect to Deerfield Public pools, it was also noted by Deerfield Parks & Recreation that if the social distancing rules are still in place, that at the public pools there will be designated time periods for swimming and people will be required to call and make a reservation for a certain time period to come to the pool, you will have to show an I.D. to get into the pool once your time period is up you will have to leave the pool. There will be staff to enforce the social distancing rules.

Here at Coromandel there is no staff to enforce social distancing and sanitizing requirements for the pool or exercise room. Because of that fact it would not be safe to open the pools or exercise room at this time.

As the situation progresses and changes, the status of the pools/exercise room can be reexamined.
